Horse teeth continue to grow throughout their entire life. Eating wears down the teeth, but uneven edges, spikes, and hooks can develop; causing sores and discomfort on the cheeks and tongue.

Dental work on your horse not only soothes any discomfort for your horse's mouth, but it also aids in helping the bit sit correctly for riding and make sure all food is able to be chewed correctly.

Sheath Cleaning

Sheath cleaning is important because excretion is removed from buildup that he cannot remove himself. Smegma can buildup and cause irritation. If horse's sheaths are not cleaned it can increase chance of infections.

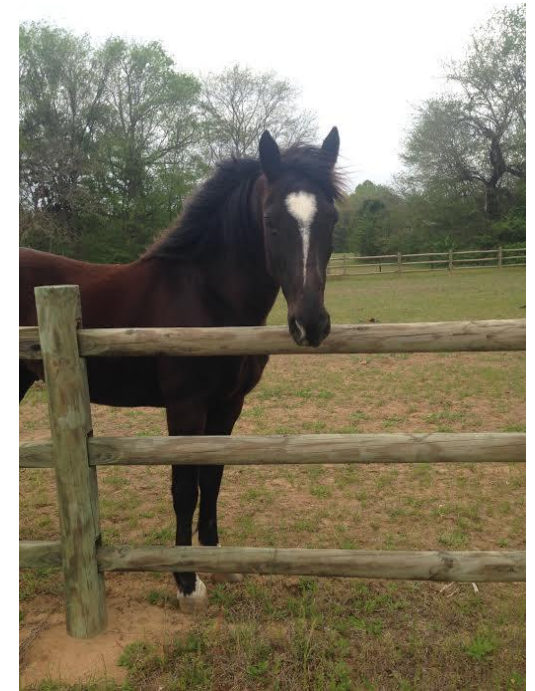

Preventative Care

Preventative Health care for your horse can prevent disease and maximize their quality of life. Proper care includes regular check-ups, vaccinations, parasite control and dental care. Our goal is to help keep your horse healthy and happy.

Equine Immunization Support Guarantee- North Star honors our vaccine guarantee stating: We will support reasonable diagnostic and treatment costs up to \$5,000 if a horse is properly vaccinated with us.

WN/EWT- includes West Nile, Eastern- Western Encephalomyelitis, Venezuelan Encephalomyelitis, and Tetanus Toxoid.

EHV/F- Vaccinates against respiratory disease: rhinopneumonitis, influenza and equine herpes virus.

Rabies- a rapidly progressive neurological disease that is often fatal. The vaccine is the primary way to prevent your horse from transmitting this disease.

Farm Calls Two semi-annual visits to your horse farm by one of our doctors in order to provide optimum preventative care and treatment. (2)

Comprehensive Physical Examination

Annual complete and thorough system-wide examination with digitized patient-specific record and report card. (1) Along with unlimited exams when brought into clinic.

Core and Risk Based Vaccinations

- ◆ West Nile Virus, Eastern & Western Encephalitis, Tetanus -WN/EWT(2)
- ◆ Equine Herpes Virus, Influenza – EHV/F (2)
- ◆ Rabies –(1)

Blood Screening and Early Detection Profile:

- ◆ *Complete Blood Count* – detection of infectious disease and anemia
- ◆ *Chemistry 17* – evaluates liver and kidney function
- ◆ *Coggins Test* – detects the presence of Equine Infectious Anemia
- ◆ *McMasters Quantitative Fecal Exam* – detects and measures the level on internal parasites

Dental Care

- ◆ Dental Examination and Evaluation
- ◆ Teeth table leveling and float
- ◆ Procedure sedation and patient monitoring



Additional Services:

- ◆ Two additional comprehensive physical exams during the year
- ◆ Sheath Cleaning
- ◆ Deworming for Internal Parasites
- ◆ Reduced cost of subsequent farm calls
